

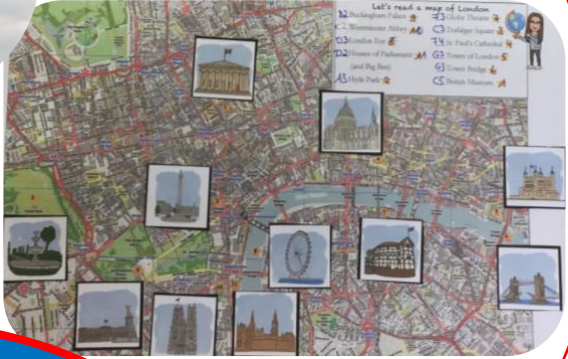
London Calling (6b, 6d)

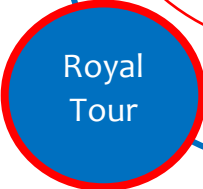
Mind the Gap - The Tube
